## **E. Delivery Process for Bullet Proof Vests:**

### **(a) Delivery Points:**

- The Supplier **MUST** deliver all bullet proof vests directly to the Head Office [DOT - King William's Town];
- Each delivery **MUST** be in terms of Traffic Officers working and attached to the Province as per the list of sizes.

### **(b) Sorting and Packaging:**

- Bullet proof vests supply for each Traffic Officer **MUST** be packed/sealed in its bag and be marked with the name of the Traffic Officer, a label stating the size of the bullet proof vest for ease of allocation, tracking and tracing;

### **(c) Delivery Period of the Bullet Proof Vests:**

- The first supply of the Uniform **MUST** be delivered by at least not later than September 2021;

### **(d) Management of delivery process:**

- At the delivery point there **MUST** always be a representative from the supplier and the Department to ensure that delivery is in order and the bullet proof vests fit to all the Traffic Officers as per given measurements;

### **(e) Management of Returns:**

- The returns for whatever reasons, **MUST** be taken back by the representative of the supplier from the delivery point;
- The supplier **MUST** return the returns within twenty-one [21] days from the date of receipt;
