



### Bidders must take particular note of the following:

A service provider is required for diesel mechanical development process of ARPL for internal candidates within the Eastern Cape Department of Transport (DOT)

- a) QCTO accreditation as a Diesel Mechanical Trade Test Centre
- b) Registered on the Central Supplier Database (CSD).
