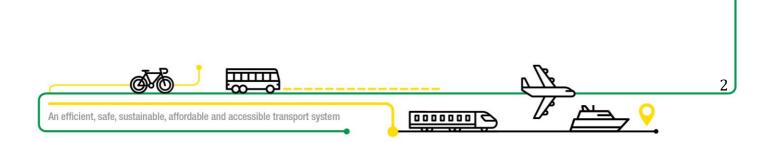

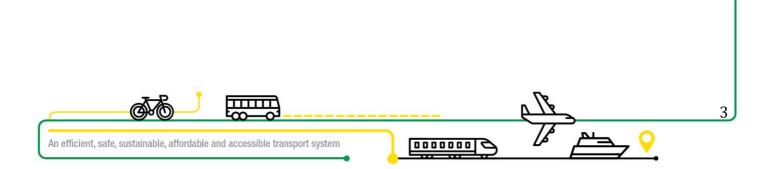

The Department of Transport invites quotations from suitable Service Providers for the training of 100 NYS learners on pathway modules for an Occupational Certificate: Office Administrator for a period of 10 days. The Service Provider requirements are as follows:

- Training will be for a period of approximately 10 days in East London for 100 NYS leaners.
- Training Service Providers must be accredited with a Development Quality Partner QCTO
- Training approach/methodology for the actual training to accompany the submissions. Failure to submit such will render the bid non-responsive.
- The approach and methodology to be used by the Services Provider will be key to ensuring the desired outcome. The use of established participatory tools and processes is critical.
- Service Providers must provide a Track Record of training conducted for learnerships or apprenticeships in the Eastern Cape accompanied by a database of trained Candidates (a minimum of 3 years experience of these types of training is required).
- Service Providers must make available curricula vitae of facilitators/assessors and moderators with certified copies of their qualifications (three traceable contactable references are required as well).
- Service Providers must make training materials available to each NYS learner.
- Service Providers must cover the following modules:
 - 1. Introduction to Office Administration
 - 2. Work readiness
 - 3. Document management

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- Assessment of learner achievements must be done by the QCTO for the provision of the above modules that contribute towards an Occupational Certificate: Office Administrator.
- Service Providers must ensure that the QCTO moderates the achievements of learners who meet the requirements of these modules.
- Valid Certificates of Completion for the above-mentioned modules must be issued to the 100 NYS learners within 30 days from the last day of training.
- A copy of the signed close-out report on the training outcomes and recommendations with all the relevant supporting documents must be submitted to the Department after training (an electronic version of the close-out report with an Excel spreadsheet of the trained 100 NYS learners must also be submitted).

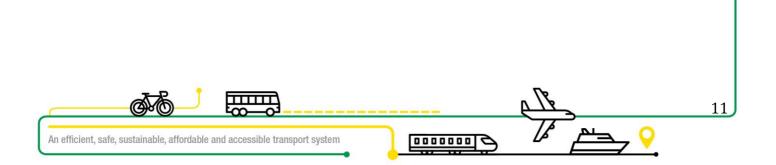

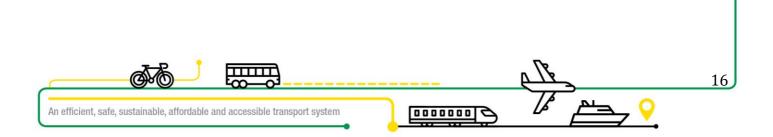
