Bidders must take particular note of the following:

- Service providers are kindly requested to submit price quotations on the attached pricing schedule for the specified items / service.
- By submitting the price quotation, it is accepted that you fully understand the requirements of this
 invitation and have familiarized yourself with the General Conditions of Contract (GCC) available on
 National Treasury website.
- The tender will be evaluated according to the preferential procurement model in the preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act (PPPFA 5 of 2000): Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2022 as well as the SCM Policy of the Department of Transport.
- In the case of a JV tender, each party must supply a valid tax certificate and a letter of good standing.
- The tenderers must ensure that they complete and sign the SBD 1, SBD 4, SBD 6.1
- The amount reflected on the Form of Offer and Acceptance takes precedence over any other total amount indicated elsewhere in the Bidders tender submission. If the Form of Offer and Acceptance has no value or figure, the bidder will be regarded as having made no offer and therefore nonresponsive.
- Bidders must have provided supporting documentation as per the bid specification schedule requirement;
- Bidders who are not registered for VAT are not eligible to claim VAT in their pricing;
- Bidders should take note that price is not a determining factor to award the bid.



Furthermore, quotation offers will only be accepted if:

- Bidders are registered with Central Supplier Database (CSD) with Treasury prior to submitting this RFQ (see https://secure.csd.gov.za/).
- The tenderer is in good standing with SARS as verified on the Central Supplier Database.
- The tenderer or any its directors or shareholders is not listed on the register of tender defaulters in terms of the prevention and compacting of corrupt activities Act of 2004 as a person prohibited from doing business within the public sector.
- The tenderer has not abused the employers Supply Chain Management System or failed to perform on any previous contract and has been given written notice to this effect.



SPECIFICATION

1. Purpose

The Department of Transport intends to appoint an independent registered surveyor to conduct a check survey and verify the quantities of material placed for the different road layers, compares the design levels with actual material placed, measurement of material on stockpile throughout the site and measurement within the borrow pits to establish how much material has been removed with respect to Contract SCMU10-19/20-0024: Upgrading of DR08606 from Sterkspruit to Mlamli Hospital Road (+/- 12 kms).

A report needs to be submitted to the Employer detailing the quantity of material placed per roadlayer and stockpile quantities.

2. Background

The Eastern Cape Department of Transport (EC_DoT) is currently in the process of upgrading a portion of DR08606 (+/- 12 kms) from Sterkspruit to past the Mlamli Hospital.

The construction of the road is currently 60% completed.

The Auditor General of South Africa (AGSA) audited the project during the 2022/2023 financial year and their audit shows several discrepancies with respect to quantities of several items (specifically roadlayers and stockpiles quantities) claimed and paid.


A locality plan is shown in Figure 1.

2.1 MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

Expertise that will enable the potential service provider to perform the task:

Registered with the required professional body;

FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THE PRE-QUALIFICATION CRITERIA WILL INVALIDATE YOUR BID



3. PHYSICAL SCOPE OF WORKS

3.1 Standard Specifications

The survey services to be carried out shall be in accordance with the relevant requirements of the COLTO: TMH11: 2013 (Final Draft). Please also note and take into account the requirements of Annexure 21 regarding the symbols and line styles.

3.2 Details to be Surveyed

The Services which are to be provided in connection with the appointment are as follows, but not limited to:

- Verify and/or establish a suitable survey reference beacon system. Details of the current reference beacon system and data will be provided to the appointed surveyor.
- Roadworks checks are anticipated for the following aspects: check levels on the top of fill and all layer works for quality control purposes, checks on the setting out of miscellaneous structures (gabion walls).
- For quantity purposes, the surveying of road levels to compare the design levels with the Contractor's levels, measurement of material on stockpile throughout the site, measurement within the borrow pits to establish how much material has been removed.

All the above will have to be co-ordinated with the appointed consultant and contractor.

3.3 General:

The survey shall be provided as a set of co-ordinated Y X Z points, linked by the Surveyor to form a digital terrain model for area measurement of material on stockpile throughout the site, measurement within the borrow pits to establish how much material has been removed or remained behind. The survey must be to enable the extraction of accurate cross-sections at any point within the terrain model using software such as Modelmaker, Microstation and AutoCad.

3.4 Survey control pegs and benchmarks

A list of survey beacons which were established in 2021 is attached. It is expected that these beacons could have been disturbed and or destroyed and the surveyor shall provide new beacons if instructed. (See attached)

These pegs shall be provided in accordance with TMH11: 2013 (Final Draft) requirements and will be used for final construction.

All permanent survey control pegs shall be numbered in sequence in the direction of increasing stake values.

Only the station number, e.g. PRD 23 (the year can be left off), has to be shown.

All survey shall conform to the WGS84 (WG) reference system.


3.5 Digital Terrain Model and CAD Drawing Requirements

The survey shall be provided as a set of labelled co-ordinated points (label, Y X Z description) in ASCII format as well as in a Model Maker DTM format. The observation points are to be correctly line linked so as to create a triangulated DTM from which contours can be generated.

The co-ordinated points to be used in the generation of the terrain model must be uniquely named so as to enable the designer to easily identify the significance of each point. The Surveyor shall provide a full list of the actual descriptions used.







Only points indicating details that are on ground level and can be used for contouring are to be included in the main DTM files as "Layer 1". The survey control pegs must be provided as "Layer 2" and the remaining information e.g. manhole positions, on other layers on the CAD drawing.

In addition to the above ASCII file, the Surveyor shall be responsible for the preparation of the CAD survey drawing, in .dgn and .dwg format, on which all terrain features are shown. The features must be grouped on logical layers in the file. Line types, symbols, text size, hatching, etc., must conform to TMH11: 2013 (Final Draft) drafting specifications. The scale on PDF drawing is to be 1:1000.

Plans shall be carefully checked after completion by the Surveyor, both in the field and office. A set of marked up field checked paper plots must be supplied as proof of adherence to TMH11: 2013 (Final Draft), which states that "The completeness of all topographic detail shall be determined by a thorough inspection in the field".

4. **DELIVERABLES**

The following data shall be supplied to the Employer:

- 4.1 Survey records in .pdf format.
- 4.2 Complete CAD drawings preferably in MicroStation (.dgn), and Autocad (.dwg) format.
- 4.3 An ASCII file of all the spotshots and interpolation data in Civil Designer and Model Maker DTM format.
- 4.4 An ASCII file with all the permanent survey beacons' final coordinates and elevations for the road.
- 4.5 Cross Sections of areas surveyed.
- 4.6 Report with detailed quantities of material placed.

5. PROGRAMME

The anticipated period for the construction works is 12 months until completion, with commencement of the works contract during December 2020 and completion due towards the end of August 2024.

The appointed surveyor will report directly to the Engineer and or the consultant's supervisory staff for the duration of the contract.

6. **DURATION OF PROJECT**

The term of the project will be two (2) months from the date of acceptance of the award/ purchase order.

7. VALIDITY OF BID

The validity of the offer is sixty (60) days.

8. GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

- The latest general conditions of contract law will apply.
- Where special conditions of the contract are in conflict with these general conditions, the special conditions shall apply.







9. SPECIAL CONDTIONS OF CONTRACT


a. Conditions of Contract

- The service provider awarded the contract is expected to charge fees at the rates not higher than those issued by the Department of Labour
- The ceiling price of the bid to be completed on the **Pricing Schedule** form must reflect all costs including VAT and disbursements.
- No late, faxed, electronically transmitted, photocopied, incomplete, copies or unsigned bids will be accepted. Only original bids fully completed and filled in black ink will be accepted.
- It is critical for service providers to fully present the credentials of key personnel to be assigned to projects.
- The Department shall not enter into a contract where a company has directors, partners or employees who are employed by the state where permission has not been granted by the Executive Authority.
- All documents submitted and/or produced shall become the property of the DOT.
- The service provider undertakes to provide the professional resources required to attain the project objectives.
- Service Providers who have entered into a consortium / Joint Venture must attach signed agreements by all partners and each party thereto must comply with all the bidding requirements.
- Bidders are requested to submit one envelope marked on the outside indicating the name of the bidding company (Bidder) and the bid number;
- The overall price must be in **Rand** and must be inclusive of VAT where applicable;
- The selected service provider will have to sign a Service Level Agreement and SBD 7.2 contract form with the Department of Transport immediately upon acceptance of the bid.
- The service provider undertakes to act as an independent contractor in respect of all work to be done.
- The service provider shall exercise all reasonable skill, care and diligence in the execution of the work and shall carry out all its obligations in accordance with international professional / PSIRA standards;









- The service provider shall, in all professional matters, act as a faithful adviser to the DOT and, in so far as any of its duties being discretionary, act fairly between DOT and third parties;
- The service provider shall execute and complete the work strictly in accordance with this contract to the satisfaction of the DOT:
- The service provider shall be deemed to have satisfied itself as to the correctness and sufficiency of the rates and prices set out in the contract for the work to be rendered;
- The service provider shall not have the power or authority to enter into any contract or otherwise to bind or incur any liability on behalf of the DOT;
- B-BBEE level certificate must be provided where necessary (Original document or original certified copy)
- Joint ventures or Consortiums must submit a consolidated BBBEE level Certificate / sworn affidavit.
- The service provider must be registered in the Centralised Supplier Database (CSD); The CSD registration report must have been printed at least ten (10) days prior the closing date of the bid
- It's the responsibility of every bidder to provide the Department with a SARS "PIN" to verify the tax compliance status at any time prior to the award of the bid.
- DOT will not be liable to reimburse any costs incurred by any service provider during the proposal /bidding process;
- The service provider shall attend meetings with officials whenever required to do so by the representative for the purpose of obtaining information or advice in regard to the work and assignments or any matters arising thereof;
- Replacement of candidates for this assignment will not be allowed except in extreme cases and the new candidates must possess the same educational and training qualifications or higher than that of the predecessor which will be agreed upon in writing between the service provider and the Department.
- All the submitted documents must be completed in full and signed where necessary.
- In cases where two or more bidders attain equal number of points in all aspects of evaluation, the bidder who has the highest B-BBEE points will be the preferred bidder.
- In cases where there is a tie in all aspects of evaluation then the award must be decided by the drawing of lots.
- Failure to submit the documentation as prescribed may lead to the bid being considered nonresponsive and subsequently rejected / not considered.
