QUOTATION EVALUATION CRITERIA:

EVALUATION CRITERIA:

1. The quotation will be evaluated using the two (2) stages; therefore, the Bidders shall take note of the following Bid Conditions and Stages of evaluation:

Stage One - Compliance

Stage Two - Price Points and SPECIFIC GOALS

1.1. STAGE ONE - Compliance:

Bidders must take further particular note of the following:


- Prospective Bidders must be accredited by and registered with the Quality Council for Trades and Occupations (QCTO) for Diesel Mechanical. (VALID CURRENT PROOF OF REGISTRATION MUST BE PROVIDER PER TRADE WHICH THE BIDDER IS TENDERING)
- Bidders are required to be registered with Centralized Suppliers Database [CSD] with treasury <u>prior to submitting</u> this quote;
- The <u>SDB 1, SBD 3.1, Bid pricing form, SBD 4, SBD 6.1</u> forms <u>MUST</u> be fully completed and submitted with the quotation;
- Bidders must complete SBD 3.1. Failure to complete SBD 3.1 will render the bidder non-responsive;
- Bidders must take cognizance that this bid is, a RATES ONLY;
- > Bidders must be legal entity or partnership (consortium);
- Bidders must provide supporting documentation as per the Quotation specification schedule requirement;

- The tenderer is in good standing with SARS as verified on the Central Supplier Database.
- The tenderer or any its directors or shareholders is not listed on the register of tender defaulters in terms of the prevention and compacting of corrupt activities Act of 2004 as a person prohibited from doing business within the public sector.
- The tenderer has not abused the employers Supply Chain Management System or failed to perform on any previous contract and has been given written notice to this effect.
- All quotations shall be held <u>valid for **30 days**</u> after the closing date. The Department reserves the right <u>not to accept the lowest</u> or any tender.





1. BACKGROUND

The Eastern Cape Department of Transport requires the appointment of service providers for Diesel Trade that is merSETA/QCTO accredited and SAQA registered to facilitate the following Occupational Trade as per Table 1.1:

Furthermore, the valued summed in **Evaluation of Bids Rates, hereunder par. 3** will be used solely for ranking purposes per trade.

No specific quantities can be indicated at this stage due to potential variances, such as integrated training on modules required for Trade Test readiness – Gap Training etc. This procuring method, according to quantified need, will result in greater efficiency in terms of the appointment of a service provider for Diesel Mechanical ARPL.

2. RATES ONLY BID

The bid is based on <u>RATES ONLY</u> and will be adjudicated accordingly.



3. EVALUATION OF BID RATES

The outcomes (steps) will be grouped, and the following criteria will be used <u>to evaluate</u> the bids for **Ranking Purposes Only** from the schedules of rates:

4. PRE-REQUISITE FOR ARPL

Service providers are required for Diesel Trade Development process of ARPL for internal candidates within the Eastern Cape Department of Transport (ECDOT) and the following is relevant:

- a) merSETA/QCTO accredited and registered at SAQA as a service provider as per the relevant Trade Test Centre i.e., Diesel Mechanical
- b) Registered on the Central Supplier Database (CSD).

5. RATES FOR BID

5.1 Completeness of Bid document

It is important for an evaluation purpose that every <u>column</u> in the schedule relating to the item offered is completed. Failure to <u>complete this column - pertaining to the occupational trade</u> will result in **exclusion** from the official list pertaining to this occupational trade.


6. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

6.1. The service provider is responsible to provide all the required relevant material for the courses.









7. NOTIFICATION OF SUPPLY OF SERVICES REQUIREMENTS

- 7.1 The procedure to be followed for notification when the services are required during normal working hours, will be:
 - i) The service provider will be advised <u>via e-mail</u> what particular services is required, the date, when it is to commence, the name of the person who is in charge of the facilitation and the period for which it will be required.
 - ii) An Official Order will be given to the Service Provider as soon as possible and must be able to supply the services within maximum of **30 working days** or the given timeframe of receiving the official order.
 - iii) Where a Services Provider cannot provide the service, the provider must communicate and provide reason why they cannot <u>offer the services within 48</u> hours confirm via email. The Department will make alternative arrangements to ensure that services to be delivered, will not be hampered.
 - iii) The Official Order Form will be submitted to the Service Provider within 3 days of the telephonic order. The service provider must not provide services without an official order.
 - iv) No payment will be made for any services provided, other than that specified on the Official Order Form.
 - v) A minimum of 24 hours' notice shall be given to the Service Provider by the Employer in writing for the termination of the order.

8. INVOICE

The invoice shall refer to the official Order Number and shall have attached thereto copies of the training outcomes confirmed by a representative of the employer.

9. ESCALATION

From the <u>signing of the Service Level Agreement (SLA)</u> for the whole duration of the contract period the cost for the courses provided by the service providers is expected to adhere to the following escalation schedule where annual increases will be made provision for as follows:



10. CONTRACT PERIOD

This contract period is intended to run for two years (24 months) after the award but can be terminated at any time.



Bidders shall base their proposals on the information provided; should bidders identify omissions (either of their own or those requested by these terms of reference), these should be listed separately so that the bulk of the proposals can be evaluated on an equal basis between all bids.









SCOPE OF WORK:

A panel of services providers is required for the process of ARPL <u>as stipulated in Table 1.1 above</u>. They should cover the following development elements, requirements, and milestones as required for Trade Test and the 8 steps hereunder are pertinent:

Step 1:

Evaluation/Pre-Assessment on modules required for Trade Test (2 days):

- i. The evaluation needs to cover all modules related to the occupational trade.
- ii. The employer to receive a comprehensive report on each evaluated candidate pertaining to skills and knowledge competencies and gaps on each required module with recommendations and required interventions, from Service Provider within (5 days) upon completion of evaluation.

The employer to receive a comprehensive report on the development process for each candidate pertaining to improvement/non-improvement of skills and knowledge competencies with regard to gaps of applicable module(s) for each candidate with final recommendations and required interventions, from Service Provider within (5 days) upon completion of evaluation process.



Application for Trade Test / <u>serial number</u> and booking of the Pre-Trade Test dates (Within <u>2 days</u> from receipt of Toolkit/Pre-Assessment Test Results)

Step 5:

Pre-Trade Test on all modules of for the relevant trade as per the following:

- i. Pre-Trade Test to be executed at Service Provider with all the required testing equipment available.
- ii. The employer to receive a comprehensive report on the result for each candidate pertaining to skills and knowledge competency gaps of applicable module(s) for each candidate with final recommendations and required interventions, from Service Provider within (5 days) upon completion of Pre-Trade Test process.
