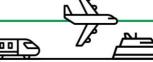

Scope Of Work

Initial Inspection

From the interactive display, confirm that the UPS in "Normal" operating mode, if not – investigate.

Remove Covers

Undo all cover bolts and remove covers to expose internal components as well as connection terminals.

Measurements:

Using a calibrated multimeter, measures, and record:

Voltages (Input & Output)

Above readings are taken at the input and output terminals.

Battery Voltage

The reading should be made on the battery connection terminals.

Phase Error Voltages

Phase error is measures between the input and output phases whilst the inverter is supporting the load.

Frequencies (Input and Output)

Frequencies are recorded from Input and Output terminals.

Currents (Input and Output)

Measures the currents on the input and output cables.

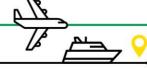
SWITCH UNIT OFF:

If readings are within acceptable limits, switch the unit to static bypass, follow the switching procedure and place unit into maintenance bypass. Isolate the UPS locally confirming the load is powered by mains.









VISUAL AND MECHANICAL INSPECTION:

Check all power and control cable connections, confirm, all bolted connections are tight, and all plug connections are seated correctly, confirm all crimp points.

CLEAN UNIT:

Using compressed air, blow out and wipe it down removing any dust and debris.

ENERGIZE:

Using compressed air, blow out the unit and wipe it down removing any dust and debris.

ENERGIZE:

Energize the UPS following the prescribed procedure, confirm the correct outcomes and measures the relevant parameters following every step. Recalibrate the units where measurement and displayed parameters differ.

TEST BATTERY BACKUP:

Initiate the battery discharge test by failing the rectifier input to the unit, continuously monitor the DC voltage and discharge current. Upon completion, return the supply and confirm charging current by measurement.

CLOSE UNIT:

Return all covers removed earlier to cover the internal components for safety reasons.

SETTINGS:

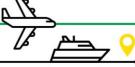
Connect the unit and download any required reports and logs. Adjust/Reset all necessary parameters.

CONFIRM OPERATION:

Confirm unit is in "Normal" operating mode from the interactive display.

1.6 The organ of state reserves the right to require of a tenderer, either before a tender is adjudicated or at any time subsequently, to substantiate any claim in regard to preferences, in any manner required by the organ of state.

2. **DEFINITIONS**

- (a) "tender" means a written offer in the form determined by an organ of state in response to an invitation to provide goods or services through price quotations, competitive tendering process or any other method envisaged in legislation;
- (b) "price" means an amount of money tendered for goods or services, and includes all applicable taxes less all unconditional discounts;
- (c) "rand value" means the total estimated value of a contract in Rand, calculated at the time of bid invitation, and includes all applicable taxes;
- (d) "tender for income-generating contracts" means a written offer in the form determined by an organ of state in response to an invitation for the origination of income-generating contracts through any method envisaged in legislation that will result in a legal agreement between the organ of state and a third party that produces revenue for the organ of state, and includes, but is not limited to, leasing and disposal of assets and concession contracts, excluding direct sales and disposal of assets through public auctions; and
- (e) "the Act" means the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, 2000 (Act No. 5 of 2000).

4. POINTS AWARDED FOR SPECIFIC GOALS

- 4.1. In terms of Regulation 4(2); 5(2); 6(2) and 7(2) of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, preference points must be awarded for specific goals stated in the tender. For the purposes of this tender the tenderer will be allocated points based on the goals stated in table 1 below as may be supported by proof/ documentation stated in the conditions of this tender:
- 4.2. In cases where organs of state intend to use Regulation 3(2) of the Regulations, which states that, if it is unclear whether the 80/20 or 90/10 preference point system applies, an organ of state must, in the tender documents, stipulate in the case of—
 - (a) an invitation for tender for income-generating contracts, that either the 80/20 or 90/10 preference point system will apply and that the highest acceptable tender will be used to determine the applicable preference point system; or
 - (b) any other invitation for tender, that either the 80/20 or 90/10 preference point system will apply and that the lowest acceptable tender will be used to determine the applicable preference point system,

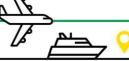
