






QUOTATION EVALUATION CRITERIA:

1. STAGES OF EVALUATION

The quotation will be evaluated using the two (2) stages; therefore, the Bidders shall take note of the following Bid Conditions and Stages of evaluation:

Stage One - Compliance

Stage Two - Price Points and SPECIFIC GOALS

STAGE ONE - Compliance:

Bidders must take further particular note of the following:

- Prospective Bidders must be registered, and their courses accredited by the relevant SETA
 and also registered under SAQA and be able to facilitate a Short Courses as per Table 1.1.
 (CURRENT VALID PROOF OF REGISTRATION MUST BE PROVIDER) (If proof is not
 provided the bid will be deemed as non-responsive).
- A Service provider to submit proof of previous experience of <u>at least 3 three years</u> via testimonials together with contactable reference. (If proof is not provided the bid will be deemed as non-responsive).

- Bidders must be legal entity or partnership (consortium);



- The tenderer is in good standing with SARS as verified on the Central Supplier Database. "Bidders must note that in addition to being tax complaint at the time of award of the contract, which will be verified with SARS or the CSD, it is incumbent upon the successful bidder/s to ensure that they are at all times tax compliant over the entire duration of the contract. Failure to ensure tax compliance may prevent the Department/Public Entity from issuing orders when goods/services are required. 



Likewise, the following <u>minimum number of learners/candidates</u> is applicable when determining <u>the</u> rates in the schedule.






1. TERMS OF REFERENCE – SERVICE PROVIDER.

- 1.1 Service Providers must be a <u>SETA accredited training institution</u> and accredited to roll out relevant NQF Level 01 to 05 short courses as alluded above in table 1.1 Background.
- 1.2. Service Provider should be registered with <u>SETA and provide valid current certification of accreditation and SAQA registration.</u>
- 1.3. The Service Provider needs to provide the rates per candidate inclusive of the following in the Pricing Schedule:
 - i) Course Material
- 1.4. The Travelling and Accommodation indicated separately in the pricing schedule is to cover cost for travelling and accommodation to and from the required training venue or site.
- 1.5. All training executed needs to be confirmed via sign-off from the relevant delegate official <u>for payment</u> of invoices.
- 1.6. A Service provider to submit previous <u>experience testimonials</u> together with contactable reference.
- 1.7. The Service Provider needs to make provision for <u>theoretical</u> classroom training inclusive of supply of theoretical and practical learning material beforehand to the learners at the Sites and also the collection of Portfolio of Evidence (POE) from these Sites, subsequent to the completion of theoretical training and cut-off of handing in of POE for assessment. 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1.8. On completion of the qualification the Service provider must issue out SAQA <u>accredited</u> certificates.

3 TERMS OF REFERENCE – FACILITATOR

- 3.1 The Service Provider's Facilitator (s) to submit a comprehensive Curriculum Vitae.
- 3.2 The facilitator must provide proof of the number of years' experience in this field of work.

4 RATES ONLY BID

The bid is based on **RATES ONLY** and will be adjudicated accordingly.

4.1 Completeness of Bid document



- SAQA registered and accredited SETA as a service provider as per the <u>relevant Short</u> <u>Courses</u>.
- b) Registered on the Central Supplier Database (CSD).





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6. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- 6.1 All service providers must indicate the <u>Geographical Zones as per Table 1.1 hereunder</u>, according to the most preferred Geographical Zone by a 1 and the lesser preferred Geographical Zone by a 2.
- 6.2. The service provider is responsible to provide all the required relevant material for the courses.
- 6.3. The minimum number of attendees for each course will be **5 candidates**.

7. NOTIFICATION OF SUPPLY OF SERVICES REQUIREMENTS

- 7.1 The procedure to be followed for notification when the services are required during normal working hours, will be:
 - i) The service provider will be advised <u>via e-mail</u> what particular services is required, the date, when it is to commence, the name of the person who is in charge of the facilitation and the period for which it will be required.
 - ii) An Official Order will be given to the Service Provider as soon as possible and must be able to supply the services <u>within a maximum of **14 days** or the given timeframe</u> of receiving the official order.
 - iii) Where a Services Provider cannot provide the service, the provider must communicate and provide reason why they cannot offer the services within 48 hours confirm via email. The Department will make alternative arrangements to ensure that services to be delivered, will not be hampered.
 - iv) The Official Order Form will be submitted to the Service Provider within 3 days of the telephonic order. The service provider must <u>not provide services without an official</u> <u>order.</u>
 - v) <u>No payment</u> will be made for any services provided, other than that specified on the Official Order Form.
 - vi) A minimum of 24 hours' notice shall be given to the Service Provider by the Employer in writing for the <u>termination of the order</u>.

8. INVOICE





1. BACKGROUND - SERVICES REQUIRED

1.1 <u>MINIMUM CREDITS FOR QUALIFICATION</u>

Service Provider must be a <u>SAQA accredited training institution</u> and accredited to roll out a Short Courses Accredited SAQA Registered Unit Standard NQF Aligned Training Courses as per SETA - NQF Level 01 to 05 Training.

- 1.1.1 Conducting Outcomes-Based Assessment & Conduct Moderation of Outcomes-based Assessments Training Pre-Requisites, kindly take note of the following:
 - i) <u>Minimum of 5</u> learners, **Short Courses** based on the prerequisite of <u>30 % theory and</u> <u>70% practical training</u> as per SETA guidelines.
 - ii) All training and assessments must be carried out on location provide by the client.
 - iii) Learners/Candidates after completion of the theoretical training (*i.e.*, classroom training), must be issued with an *attendance* certificate and a logbook in which to capture their practical experience gained under the supervision of a competent Operator/Mentor.
 - iv) Once the participants have completed the relevant assessments must be provided with the relevant accredited certificate and a Statement of Results.
- **1.2** Furthermore, the following is also a pre-requisite for competency training:
 - (a) All theoretical training should be executed as, uninterrupted.
 - (b) The maximum allowable ratio of facilitator to learners is **1 to 5** as stipulated above.

3.2. FORMULAE FOR DISPOSAL OR LEASING OF STATE ASSETS AND INCOME GENERATING PROCUREMENT

3.2.1. POINTS AWARDED FOR PRICE

A maximum of 80 or 90 points is allocated for price on the following basis:

Ps = Points scored for price of tender under consideration

4. POINTS AWARDED FOR SPECIFIC GOALS

- 4.1. In terms of Regulation 4(2); 5(2); 6(2) and 7(2) of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, preference points must be awarded for specific goals stated in the tender. For the purposes of this tender the tenderer will be allocated points based on the goals stated in table 1 below as may be supported by proof/ documentation stated in the conditions of this tender:
- 4.2. In cases where organs of state intend to use Regulation 3(2) of the Regulations, which states that, if it is unclear whether the 80/20 or 90/10 preference point system applies, an organ of state must, in the tender documents, stipulate in the case of—
 - (a) an invitation for tender for income-generating contracts, that either the 80/20 or 90/10 preference point system will apply and that the highest acceptable tender will be used to determine the applicable preference point system; or
 - (b) any other invitation for tender, that either the 80/20 or 90/10 preference point system will apply and that the lowest acceptable tender will be used to determine the applicable preference point system,

then the organ of state must indicate the points allocated for specific goals for both the 90/10 and 80/20 preference point system.








