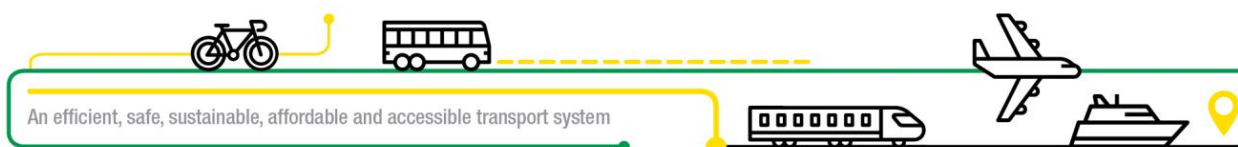

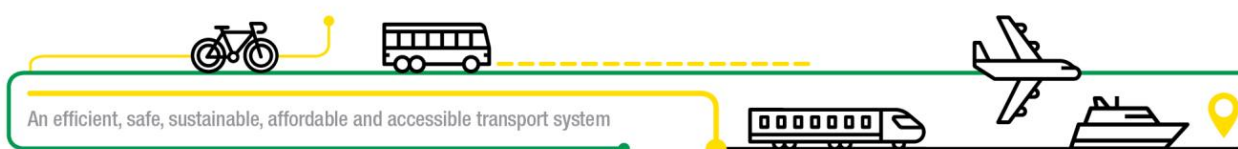

DESCRIPTION: PROVISION OF A SERVICE PROVIDER THAT WILL PROVIDE CLEANING SERVICES FOR ERF5000; THAT INCLUDES TOILET PAPERS AND CLEANING MATERIAL FOR DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORT 12 CLEANERS (4 MALES, 7 FEMALES AND 1 SUPERVISOR) FOR A PERIOD OF TWELVE 4 MONTHS

Personnel is required to work Five (5) days a week, excluding public holidays for a period of Twelve (12) months. Time from 6h00 am to 15h00 pm for eight (8) hours.

1. PERSONNEL REQUIREMENT

- a) One supervisor
- b) Five (7) female cleaners
- c) Four (4) Male cleaners

2. SCOPE OF WORK FOR DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORT (FNB BUILDING,BISHO)

2.1 OFFICE, OPEN PLANS, PASSAGES,,RECEPTION AREARS AND TOILETS

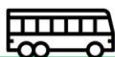
- (a) There are ninety-three (93) offices [3rd and 4th] currently, that would have to be a cleaned on daily basis at the TIMS offices, including the one (1) open plan on the 1st floor.
- (b) The three(3) lobby areas at the entrance areas of the 1st ,3rd and 4th floor areas.
- (c) The passages MUST also be cleaned DAILY within the building, all floors including the roller door areas.
- (d) The twenty-two(22) toilets MUST be cleaned DAILY and be provided with all accessories e.g. Toilet papers; Toilet disinfectants including hand wash gels, air fresheners and paper towels.
- (e) The strong-rooms, safes and store facilities MUST be cleaned at least once in a month
- (f) The kitchen and eating areas MUST be cleaned TWICE (2) per day, during teatime in the morning and after lunch time.
- (g) A cleaning of toilets MUST be done DAILY.

1.2 WINDOWS AND GLASS DOORS:

- (a) All windows in the building MUST be cleaned ONCE a month, however window seals MUST be cleaned and polished DAILY .
- (b) All glasses outside MUST be cleaned after every 6 months of the contract.
- (c) The entrance glass doors in front MUST also be cleaned DAILY including the doors at the entrance glass doors.

1.3 FURNITURE AND EQUIPMENT:

- (a) Furniture including counters MUST be cleaned
- (b) Offices and be polished DAILY. Therefore, the service provider would be expected to provide furniture polish.
- (c) Equipment MUST be wiped with clean cloths and NO furniture polish, or any other type of polish shall be applied.
- (d) The standard of furniture polish shall be that of **MR.MIN** and equivalent.
