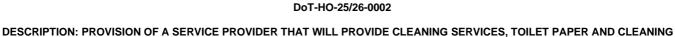

- By submitting the price quotation, it is accepted that you fully understand the requirements of this invitation and have familiarized yourself with the General Conditions of Contract (GCC) available on National Treasury website.
- The tender will be evaluated according to the preferential procurement model in the preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act (PPPFA 5 of 2000): Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2022 as well as the SCM Policy of the Department of Transport.
- In the case of a JV tender, each party must supply a valid tax certificate and a letter of good standing.

Personnel is required to work Five (5) days a week, excluding public holidays for a period of Four months. Time from 6h00 am to 15h00 pm for eight (8) hours.

## 1. PERSONNEL REQUIREMENT

- a. One female supervisor
- b. Ten (13) female cleaners
- c. Four (3) Male cleaners

# 2. OFFICES, OPENS PLANS, PASSAGES, RECEPTION AREAS AND TOILETS:

a. There are eighteen (18) offices [Ground floor and 1<sup>st</sup> floor] currently, that would have to be cleaned on daily basis at the TIMS offices, including the two (2) open plans for data capturing.

b. The two (2) foyer areas in the ground and entrance area of the building including the  $1^{st}$  floor areas.

c. The passages MUST also be cleaned DAILY within the building, all floors including the roller door areas.

d. The six (6) toilets MUST be cleaned DAILY and be provided with all accessories e.g. Toilet papers; Toilet disinfectants including hand wash gels, air fresheners and paper towels.

e. The strong-rooms, safes and store facilities MUST be cleaned at least once in two (2) weeks [Bi-weekly].

f. The kitchen and eating areas MUST be cleaned TWICE (2) per day, during teatime in the morning and after lunch time.

g. All glasses at the counter and all foyers, downstairs, upstairs including glass door in all entrance areas in and outside of the building, MUST be cleaned daily.

h. A deep toilets cleaning MUST be done DAILY.

# 3. WINDOWS AND GLASS DOORS:

a. All windows in the building MUST be cleaned ONCE a month, however window seals MUST be cleaned Dailly and polished once in a week but dusting DAILY.

b. All glasses outside MUST be cleaned after every 6 months of the contract.

c. The entrance glass doors in front MUST also be cleaned twice in a week including the doors before the stairs and in the entrance glass doors on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor.

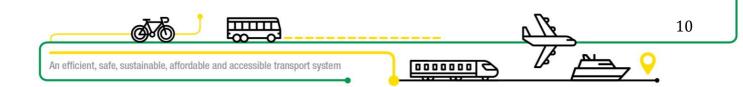

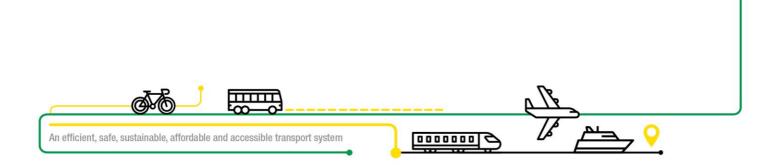

- (d) recommend that the tenderer or contractor, its shareholders and directors, or only the shareholders and directors who acted on a fraudulent basis, be restricted from obtaining business from any organ of state for a period not exceeding 10 years, after the *audi alteram partem* (hear the other side) rule has been applied; and
- (e) forward the matter for criminal prosecution, if deemed necessary.
