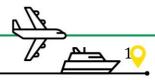

The completed Quotation documents as well as any supporting documentation must be placed in a sealed envelope, clearly marked with the Quotation number "DOT-IHC-25/26-002, SUPPLY & DELIVERY OF ASPHALT CRACK SEALANT AND COLD PREMIX FOR R72-HAMBURG PROJECT", and may be deposited in the Bid Box situated at Department of Transport, 1 Reynold's Street, Industrial Area, in Makhanda, not later than 11H00 on 28 May 2025.

Electronic, telegraphic, facsimile, and late tenders will not be accepted. Tenders may only be submitted on the tender documentation that has been issued.

Bidders using courier services for delivery of their bid documents must ensure the delivery is at the correct place / location and time as the department will not be held responsible for wrong delivery.

A Polymer-modified cold-applied sealer for asphalt and concrete suitable for sealing cracks of medium to high activity with a width of 5 -15 mm. The product will be preferred to be supplied in 25L containers.

Cold Premix

Cold Premix is specially formulated for pothole patching. Cold Premix is ideal for instant and effective repair of asphalt and concrete surface such as potholes, driveways etc.

The product should conform with TRH-8 road specifications and when applied, the completed patched area should be accessible to traffic immediately.

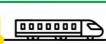

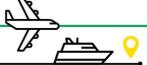

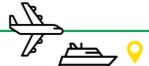

Where

Ps = Points scored for price of tender under consideration

Pt = Price of tender under consideration

Pmin = Price of lowest acceptable tender

3.2. FORMULAE FOR DISPOSAL OR LEASING OF STATE ASSETS AND INCOME GENERATING PROCUREMENT

3.2.1. POINTS AWARDED FOR PRICE

A maximum of 80 points is allocated for price on the following basis:

80/20

$$Ps = 80 \left(1 + \frac{Pt - P max}{P max} \right)$$

Where

Ps = Points scored for price of tender under consideration

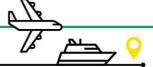

4. POINTS AWARDED FOR SPECIFIC GOALS

- 4.1. In terms of Regulation 4(2); 5(2); 6(2) and 7(2) of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, preference points must be awarded for specific goals stated in the tender. For the purposes of this tender the tenderer will be allocated points based on the goals stated in table 1 below as may be supported by proof/ documentation stated in the conditions of this tender:
- 4.2. In cases where organs of state intend to use Regulation 3(2) of the Regulations, which states that, if it is unclear whether the 80/20 preference point system applies, an organ of state must, in the tender documents, stipulate in the case of—
 - (a) an invitation for tender for income-generating contracts, that either the 80/20 preference point system will apply and that the highest acceptable tender will be used to determine the applicable preference point system; or
 - (b) any other invitation for tender, that the 80/20 preference point system will apply and that the lowest acceptable tender will be used to determine the applicable preference point system,

then the organ of state must indicate the points allocated for specific goals for the 80/20 preference point system.

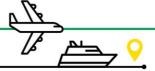

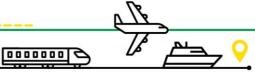

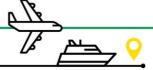
