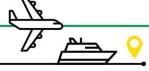

- 100-125mm top diameter Treated Timber Pole 1200mm long
- 40mm diameter Treated Timber droppers

#### b) Wire

#### i. Barbed wire

High tensile grade single strand 3,15 mm x 2,50 mm oval-shaped zinc-coated wire, with a 2,82mm equivalent diameter, fully galvanised.

#### ii. Smooth wire

- 4,00 mm diameter zinc-coated high-tensile-grade steel straining wire
- 2,50 mm diameter mild-steel zinc-coated tying wire (for tying fencing wire to standards and droppers).
- High-tensile-grade steel 2.24mm diameter zinc-coated fencing wire.

#### g) Gates

Gates shall be zinc-coated as specified in SABS 763 for class B1 articles, or painted as specified in section 8400. Gates shall be complete in every respect, including hinges, washers, bolts and locking chains attached to the gate.
